

HERITAGE BICYCLE

From your hotel, you will go to UNESCO's World Heritage Site – Georgetown. Pick up the bicycles and start to explore the city of Georgetown. First stop will be at the Chew Jetty – the fishing houses built on stilts over the sea. The jetty started by the Chew Clan during mid 19th century who came from southern China. Next, you will pass the Tanjung City Marina - the first inner city marina in the country, which was completed in October 2005. Furthermore, you will pass the Clock Tower – which was given to Penang by the local millionaire Cheah Chen Eok in 1897 to commemorate the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Victoria. The tower is 60 feet high – one foot for each year of Her Majesty's reign. Next, stop by the Peranakan Mansion. The typical home of a rich Baba who lived a century ago has been restored to offer visitors a glimpse of the opulent lifestyle and one of their many customs and traditions. There are over 1,000 pieces of antiques and collectibles of the era on display. Proceed to Little India - Spice Market and experience the hustle and bustle of Georgetown's spice trade by visiting the many wholesale and retail traders dealing with age old spices like cinnamon, cloves, nutmeg and many more. Visit Khoo Clan House – its building features a magnificent hall embellished with intricate carvings and wood work. Before the end of the tour, you may have the opportunity to ride through the town streets and pass some of the ancient pre-war buildings.
