October Coffee House	City Centre or the Peak Vista	Coffee and cheesecake
New WK Restaurant	Bundusan	Dim sum
Kedai Kopi KTC	Gaya Street	<i>Bak kut teh</i> (available at dinner time only)
The CHUBs Grill	Plaza Shell	Almost every item on this menu is tasty!
Wee Kee Restaurant	Inanam	Local delicacies such as <i>tamparuli</i> fried noodles, <i>tuaran</i> noodles, <i>sin chew</i> style fried rice noodles...lots of noodles!
Radha's Banana Leaf Restaurant	Api-Api Centre, near to office	Banana leaf rice
Yu Hiong Seafood Café	Inanam	Rice wine seafood noodles or the <i>tom yam</i> seafood noodles
